About

The EYEJ Millennial Task Force is a group of young professionals from diverse backgrounds who seek to have a positive impact on Cleveland's youth and social justice generally. It coordinates directly with other EYEJ operations such as Youth Online Discussing Justice (YODJ) and EYEJ's Connectivity Initiative to inform fundraising efforts, marketing campaigns, and other strategic initiatives and partnerships with the unique perspective and voice of the Millennial generation.

Objective

The Millennial Task Force supports the EYEJ Youth Council and other programs including YODJ and EYEJ Speaks. Recently, it also has joined EYEJ's effort to close Cleveland's Digital Divide. The group seeks to bring about real change on social justice issues in Cleveland through the empowerment of young people. Its goal is to be a diverse, inclusive network of young professionals eager to better their communities and improve lives of young people.

The Task Force

The Millennial Task Force is an expansive group of individuals who identify as members of the Millennial generation. EYEJ itself is based in Cleveland, but the Task Force is nationwide. Wherever they live, members have in common a genuine interest in advocating for and alongside young people. Gatherings take place on digital platforms on the third Thursday of every month. Meetings last approximately 45 to 60 minutes.
